# Letter from the CEO & Board Chair

**Dear Friends and Colleagues,**

This past year, we have been reminded of the one constant in life--CHANGE. We know change can be full of hope as well as worry, anxiety and stress. We also know worry, anxiety and stress are not always bad; they can propel us forward into a different direction. They help us make it through that time of change. Unfortunately, research has concluded there is a breaking point for stress, and this limit is known as toxic stress.

Toxic stress is the body's response to lasting and serious stress, without enough support from a caregiver. It is a direct result of a caregiver not being supportive or responsive to a child. Children experience toxic stress when they do not have their basic needs met, and they are continually concerned about their physical or

emotional safety. This type of stress can disrupt healthy brain development and impact the way they think, feel and grow well into adulthood.

But there's hope. KCSL's goal to create, repair and restore healthy parent-child relationships reduces the negative effects of adversity and protects children from toxic stress. When a parent or caregiver becomes physically and emotionally available, their children are able to manage change or stress in a more productive, tolerable way. This is a skill they carry with them their entire life ultimately ensuring a stronger, more resilient and educated workforce and breaking generations of negative impacts of toxic stress.

In 2021, KCSL brought positive change in Kansas by providing intensive services to over 2,000

families directly impacting over 4,500 children. We trained over 7,700 parents and professionals ensuring they have the information needed to be successful in keeping children and families safe physically and emotionally. Finally, we distributed over 59,000 educational materials to the community bringing awareness to topics that support parents and prevent child abuse.

*Thank you for supporting our parents and caregivers at KCSL.* Because of your support, we are able to break cycles of neglect, abuse and trauma.

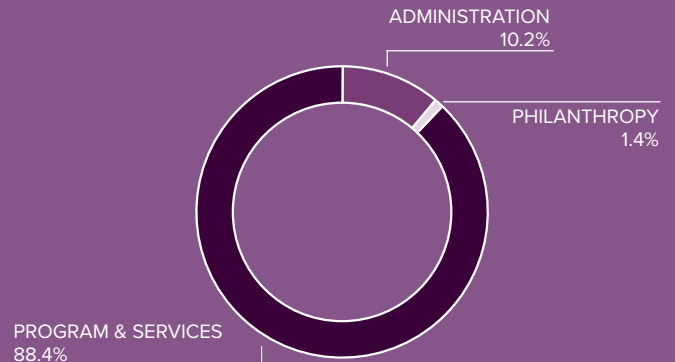
